Join youth and adults from all over the country for **UUSC's Freedom Summer**, a weeklong historical journey that will take you to some of the most significant sites of the civil rights movement.

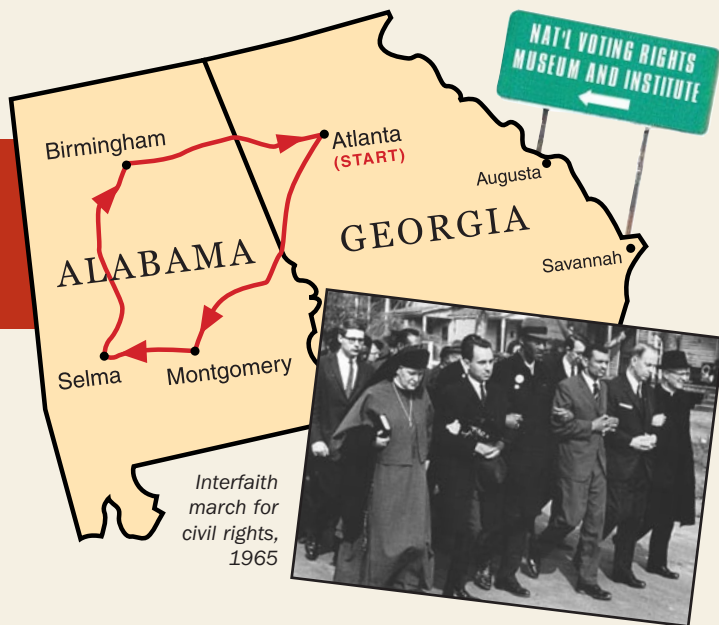
You'll visit Atlanta, Montgomery, Selma and Birmingham. See where history was made and hear the stories of those who were
