Dear President Biden,

We, the undersigned, write as Unitarian Universalist organizations, churches, and individuals, to express our grave concern that your administration continues to block and expel asylum-seekers at our border. We respectfully call on you to take the following steps to restore fair access to asylum as swiftly as possible.

- **End Misuse of Title 42:** Rescind executive authority for expulsions under Title 42 and cease all such expulsions;
- **Restore Asylum:** Resume processing asylum-seekers through ports of entry, while complying with public health mitigation measures—including social distancing, masking, and free and universal access to vaccination—to ensure the safety of asylum-seekers, officials, and other members of the public;
- **Fight “Remain in Mexico”:** Pursue all legal avenues to terminate any iteration of the so-called Migrant Protection Protocols (MPP) policy;
- **Reduce Immigration Detention:** Halt the expansion of civil immigration detention during the pandemic and release people from custody; restoring access to asylum must not be used as a pretext to expand the use of detention.

The misuse of the Centers for Disease Control’s authority under **42 U.S. Code § 265**

as a justification for expelling asylum-seekers, without a chance to plead their case, is in violation of the international Refugee Convention. Public Health experts have weighed in against this misuse of Title 42, arguing that it has no scientific basis. Title 42 can no longer be explained as a Trump-era policy, since your administration has not only renewed its use multiple times, but even carried out a *greater number of expulsions than the prior administration*—[more than one million expulsions during the first year.](#)

Your anti-asylum policies also contradict your administration's explicit promises, both on the campaign trail and in office. As candidates for high office, Joe Biden and Kamala Harris pledged to [“restore our asylum laws so that they do what they should be designed to do—protect people fleeing persecution and who cannot return home safely.”](#) Shortly after their inauguration, President Biden issued an executive order requiring the Department of Homeland Security to [“promptly begin taking steps to reinstate the safe and orderly reception and processing of arriving asylum seekers\[.\]”](#) Yet more than a year later, your administration continues to systematically deny access to asylum at the U.S.-Mexico border.

Each day your administration's anti-asylum restrictions remain in effect, refugees are being forcibly sent to unsafe conditions in Mexican border towns or returned to the hands of their persecutors in their home countries. [Human rights observers have documented more than 8,700 attacks—including kidnapping, torture, and sexual violence](#)—against asylum-seekers returned to Mexico under U.S. policies since President Biden took office. This number does not include those killed upon return to their home countries. Your administration has also sent nearly 20,000 Haitian asylum-seekers back to Haiti—without any access to their legal right to an asylum hearing—at a time when Haiti is facing an unprecedented political, economic and health crisis.

The Unitarian Universalist faith has a powerful legacy of journeying alongside those who flee their homes from danger. During the Holocaust, [Rev. Waitstill and Martha Sharp](#), who later founded the Unitarian Universalist Service Committee, undertook major risks and sacrifice to create avenues for Jewish families and others targeted by the Nazis to escape to the U.S. At that time, similar to today, their work stood in opposition to the U.S. government's own efforts to limit immigration, such as [in 1939 when the MS St. Louis, a ship carrying Jewish refugees, was turned back by immigration authorities in Miami.](#) Over one third of the ship's 937 passengers were murdered after being forced to return to Europe.

As people inspired by the Unitarian Universalist tradition, our faith emphasizes the inherent worth and dignity of all people and calls us to seek justice, equity and compassion in human relations. In this case, that means restoring fair access to asylum, as swiftly as possible. With the number of Covid-19 cases in rapid decline and U.S. borders open for shopping and tourism, public health cannot justify denying access to asylum.

In no uncertain terms, we urge you to fully rescind the policies of the prior administration that have multiplied the suffering of thousands upon thousands of people already in crisis.
