# Instructions

1. Cut out the two shapes along the dotted lines.
2. Fold away from you along the red lines.
3. Use a glue stick to put glue in marked purple areas.
4. Place the white square in between the two colored squares, matching star with star and moon with moon.
5. Press down glue areas and secure with tape.
