advance these goals. In order to accomplish this, we offer justice

education and leadership development; engagement and mobilization for

advocacy; partner support; and grant funding.

UUSC aims to leverage our particular strategic assets and strengths to disrupt criminalization and systemic oppression of people based on their identities; support self-determination and defend the rights of people who are or may be forced to leave the places they call home due to climate, conflict, or economic hardship, and address the root causes of forced displacement; and respond to humanitarian crises as partners with people whose access to aid is most limited, by helping them to rebuild their lives and by addressing the human rights issues or violations that make them more vulnerable.

In all of our work, UUSC and our partners work with the communities most affected by injustice, including:

- In Burma, all of our partners are focused on protecting the rights of
the Rohingya Muslim minority, currently facing a crisis of displacement
and a military campaign of genocide. This year, those impacts have been

impacted by the military's attempted coup and the systematic persecution of opposition leaders, activists, and the Civil Disobedience Movement that arose in response.

- In Mexico and Central America, UUSC's partners work with people who
  have been displaced from their home countries by state-sanctioned and
  gender-based violence, are at risk of being displaced, or who have been
  repatriated and are in continued danger.
- In the U.S., our partners work with criminalized populations,
  including undocumented people, those at risk of deportation, and
  humanitarian aid workers seeking to assist those making the dangerous
  journey from Mexico to the U.S. border.
- In Alaska, Louisiana, and the Pacific, UUSC's partners are advancing and protecting the rights of populations at risk of climate-forced displacement, and upholding the "right to resist" extractive development projects that threaten to displace their communities and destroy their ancestral lands, including Line 3 in Minnesota and LNG pipelines in Texas.
- In the Bahamas, UUSC is supporting grassroots partners working with
  the communities most impacted by Hurricane Dorian, including Haitian
  immigrants who are subjected to ongoing discrimination and completely
  ignored by the mainstream response to the hurricane.

UUSC seeks to involve our grassroots partners in all aspects of our

decision-making, and to adapt and adjust our strategies, practices, and

processes in accordance with their feedback. Doing so requires building

long-term, trusting relationships and finding new ways to solicit

candid and, if necessary, anonymous feedback from our partners, which

we do each and every year. This year, our partners had encouraging

means building movements for systemic change. Impact means using our
power and privilege as a US-based nonprofit to amplify the power of the
grassroots by following the leadership of communities directly affected
by injustice. It is addressing immediate harms and their root causes,
in order to dismantle oppressive systemsincluding those from which we
benefit. In short, our impact can be seen in the steps we take on the
way to building a more just, equitable, and regenerative world. These
are ambitious goals to be sure. Achieving them will take time, and the
work that will make them possible is not always quantifiable or
readymade for public consumption.

The themes, stories, and outcomes we choose to highlight in our work,
therefore, are chosen because they help us understand whether or not
our work is supporting those long-term, systemic impacts, as we strive
to make progress on our human rights goals. We are proud that many of
our highlights showcase UUSC's approach: consulting with our grassroots
partners, frontline communities, and other allies and then leveraging
whatever resources we have to make a collective impact on our shared
struggle for justice and human rights. In every case, we aim to put our
grassroots partners at the center, showing the power of social change
when it is led by communities confronting oppression and injustice.

This year, UUSC helped strengthen grassroots movements, addressed immediate harms while working toward systemic solutions, and centered the experiences and wisdom of the communities most impacted by injustice. Below are just a few of the highlights of how we did this, including by:

UUSC's years supporting community work to develop alternatives to the dominant economic and political systems of oppression were critical this year, as were our partners' analyses of how governments across the region have failed at both short-term emergency response and long-term development. The global COVID crisis and the effects of climate change have put this into sharp relief.

- COVID response: Most of our migrant justice partners either expanded existing direct food assistance programs or started new ones as needed. With emergency funds, UUSC was able to provide support for partners as they organized these immediate responses to COVID's impacts in their communities.
- o In Honduras, Nicaragua, and Guatemala, we helped our partners organize direct aid to communities and families in the form of food and cash assistance.
- o In the US, we supported the provision of grocery and rent support, as well as urgently needed access to affirming mental health services, unavailable or inaccessible elsewhere.
- o In Mexico, our partners' migrant shelters continued operating with reduced staff, though were forced to implement strict sanitary measures and temporarily stop receiving new arrivals. They adapted their

physical spaces and expanded services out into the communities by

in the Guadalajara and Mexico City metro areas. Importantly, they also
both continued to monitor ongoing migration flows across the country
and highlight inadequate and abusive Mexican state responses.

- On top of the COVID crisis, our partners in Central America were also critical in responding to the devastating impacts of the back-to-back hurricanes, Eta and Iota. Particularly here, the work that partners have been engaged with for years and their location in the affected communities enabled each of them to do three things:

o Identify the most urgent needs and plan for the medium-term o Respond to these needs quickly and with dignity
o Socialize their analyses of inadequate, abusive, and corrupt state responses and how that fits within the context of globalized

This work toward alternative systems, particularly those linked to

local agricultural development, is rooted in autonomy, sustainability,

gender equality, and anti-corruption, since it means that communities

are less reliant on government programs that are either insufficient or

often driven by patronage.

- Elections and advocacy work in the US

o Thanks to their organizing model based on established civic

engagement networks, and tireless, courageous "get out the vote" and

voter education work in the midst of an ongoing public health crisis,

our partners in Georgia were key players in the outcome of state and

federal elections there.

neoliberalism and militarization.

o Change doesn't stop once the ballots are counted, and our partners
have been vital to keeping momentum for long-term systems change:

several have continued to keep issues of migration, asylum and
sanctuary visible while holding the new Biden administration to
account.

- In collaboration with our coalition partners, the Legal Justice Coalition (co-convened by UUSC), and community leaders from the Gulf and Alaska, we released a policy brief directed to the new Biden-Harris administration, addressing climate-forced displacement in the US. We also prepared an international statement in response to President Biden's Executive Order on Climate Change and Migration, which was drafted in collaboration with partners across our 3 portfolios. The statement urged the administration to bring an intersectional human rights lens to its work to address the climate crisis, and more than 30 of our partners signed onto the statement indicating their support. - Following the release of our statement, we organized and hosted a webinar during the President's climate leader summit, which included 10 UUSC partners and community leaders from the United States, Central America, the Pacific, The Bahamas and Canada -- and representing our work on climate justice, migrant justice, and crisis response -- to demand action.

- This year, we also provided emergency funds to 10 of our of our climate justice partners to support their adaptation to the global pandemic. This included supporting communities to mobilize humanitarian aid and COVID-relief support on the ground with households that were displaced by Hurricane Laura in the Gulf, as well as bolstering aid distribution and advocacy efforts from our partners in the Pacific Islands.
- In Fiji, our support helped convene the first ever meeting of
  representatives from climate displaced communities including those who
  have been relocated (Tukuraki and Vunidogoloa) or partially relocated
  (Narikoso).

- While the COVID pandemic reverberated around the world, the

compounded effects of international aid disruptions and economic crises

were acutely felt by already vulnerable Rohingya refugee and IDP

Bangladesh refugee camps, and urban Malaysia. UUSC was able to not only

permit existing grantees to re-program their funds, much of which

focused on education and community organizing that were disrupted due

to social distancing and public health protocols, but we were also able

to make new critical emergency grants to help grassroots Rohingya

partners respond to community requests for food aid, personal

ethnic minority women activists from across Burma created a virtual convening platform focused on building connections among disparate youth activists from Burma. Though the program was designed before the COVID-pandemic, the virtual nature of the learning series ultimately timed well with social distancing and public health protocols. Over the course of 8 months and 25 sessions with various human rights experts and mentors, more than 35 youth participants from Burma, located in Burma, Thailand, Bangladesh and further afield, came together to learn, 032212 11-20-20

learning program, our partnership included 8 small grants for

participants to carry out human rights projects in their local

communities, which served as the basis for discussion, sharing and

practical learning among participants. Due to its success, the

The UU College of Social Justice (UUCSJ) is structured as a joint program of the Unitarian Universalist Service Committee (UUSC), jointly governed by the Unitarian Universalist Association (UUA) and UUSC for the benefit of both organizations under the terms of a joint operating agreement. UUCSJ's mission is to inspire and sustain faith-based activism for justice, on issues of local, national, and global importance. We accomplish this through a variety of experiential learning programs, and through workshops and resources designed for use in our UU congregations. We work closely with UUSC to center frontline grassroot partner needs and to activate UU's to serve in movement with

them.

One of the major initiatives we undertook this past year before the

pandemic hit was to support the UUA's UU the Vote Initiative leading up

to the Fall 2020 election including, recruiting and supporting young

adults as poll workers in states where the communities of color faced

voter restrictions. As part of this work, we created the 2020 Democracy

Defense & Action Resource Guide, that was available online through

January 2021 with the incoming change in the US government with the

Biden Administration.

Beginning almost immediately with the pandemic, UUCSJ staff and Program Leaders began experimenting with entirely new online offerings (in addition to adapting in-person versions to an online platform). We have now developed and offered a wide range of Community Action Circles to UU constituents and donors, ministers and religious educators, and organizers/activists with accompaniment networks, youth and young adults among others. Our Community Action Circles on zoom are a way to foster community-building, energetic grounding and connection, and collective action-taking, even while we were all physically distanced. Using interactive google slides, we created visually rich spaces that allowed people to feel less isolated, while offering timely political education and concrete opportunities to respond to action alerts from social movements in which we and our partners are involved. It has been an iterative process that we had adapted for multiple groups (including congregations, youth groups, UUA partners, the UUSC board, and national events such as the UU@UN Spring Seminar and the most recent General Assembly). We have received rave reviews for these gatherings and

continue to offer templates, training-by-doing, and coaching to

congregations and other UU justice groups that want to learn to

facilitate their own. We've engaged roughly 250 participants through

action circles over the last year and the ripple effect of our impact

is harder to predict as we've trained and mentored many activists to

bring these action circles to their own communities.

Our ability to transition to online workshops has enabled us to reach
many more congregations and develop new engaging workshops with alumni
from our programs, our network of CSJ program leaders and others to
broaden our offerings. Our workshops have served as a positive way to
strengthen our relationships with State Action Networks and the
congregations they serve. We led approximately 20 workshops this year
reaching over approximately 250 participants through workshops such as
The Revolution Will Not Be Colonized, Re-socializing for the
Revolution, Arts and activism, Faith in Action, Speaking Justice in our
Language of Faith, Saying Yes and Saying No, The Answer is in our
Bodies, How do we Imagine Justice, Praxis in the Borderlands and our
new program focused on Settler Colonialism 101.

This past year has brought challenges to our youth constituents and for those who seek to offer them meaningful opportunities for learning and connection amidst so much disruption to their social and educational lives. We have remained a resource and collaborator, whether working directly with congregational leaders or with our youth ministry focused colleagues at the UUA, bringing interactive online practices we have learned and our focus on justice education to joint endeavors. We have also remained in close contact with our partners at the organization,

BORDERLINKS so that when it is safe to resume travel, we will be well
equipped to welcome youth groups back into immersive learning journeys.

A recent stakeholder assessment of UUCSJ's work particularly
highlighted the important contributions that we continue to make to the
youth ministry landscape, even in these ever-shifting times. As one
stakeholder stated, "UUCSJ really does center young people in a way
that feels whole."

At a time when many online programs have struggled to sustain participation, the online fellowship version of our GROW (Grounded & Resilient Organizers Workshop) has expanded and sustained engagement from young adults, ages 18-35, during the past year, with more than 50 total participants who have gathered weekly for facilitated sessions to build their organizing skills in spiritually nourishing and relationally rich ways. Participants have grappled with themes related to Governance & Power, Conflict, Care, Time & Imagination, as well as the ongoing work of dismantling white supremacy, and growing their understanding of intersectional social movements. These activists were supported in contextualizing their local contexts, whether campus, congregation, and/or community and mapping power and possibilities for ongoing meaningful action, including in concert with one another. As with our prior in-person iterations of GROW, we continue to hear how meaningful and even "life changing" this program is for many young adult participants, several of whom have returned repeatedly to participate in evolving iterations and who have stayed engaged with UUCSJ in other ways, including serving as paid facilitators and leaders of our emerging programs.

Two years ago, at General Assembly, the UUA put out a call to congregations to members to strengthen their ties with indigenous partners. Since this time, UUCSJ has hosted several programs and offerings in response to this call starting with the Settler Colonialism 101 workshop in Spring of 2020. From there, we've built relationships and created new program offerings with several indigenous leaders, including some already within the UU network. We've supported non-indigenous UUs in deepening their understanding of indigenous solidarity through our Being a Good Relative workshop series and direct actions at the Treaty People Gathering in Minnesota in June 2021. Creating such offerings have allowed participants to expand their knowledge in multiple fronts, as there were participants who attended our first Settler Colonialism workshop and Being a Good Relative series who later became agitators against the Enbridge Line 3 pipelinea new w section of Enbridge pipeline is set to carry 760,000 barrels a day of tar sands oil across protected Indigenous treaty lands.

All of our programs are supported by the UUCSJ Study Guide for Cross-Cultural Engagement and by adaptations to the Guide for different age groups. They are led by staff and by our Program Leaders, who we support with an annual retreat. Our current cadre of 20 Program Leaders includes 13 ministers, seminarians or Directors of Religious Education; 11 are people of color and 8 are fluent Spanish speakers.
